HAZELDEAN ROAD WIDENING A MAJOR BENEFIT TO WEST-END

Infrastructure renewal and development is critical to the long-term viability and sustainability of the City of Ottawa. With this in mind, the significant financial investment by all three levels of government into the widening of Hazeldean Road, as part of the Infrastructure Stimulus Fund, emphasizes the importance of infrastructure renewal.

“Given the growth rate of the residential and commercial bases along this east/west corridor, and throughout the Stittsville-Kanata West area, the value of this investment cannot be stressed enough,” said Stittsville-Kanata West Councillor Shad Qadri.

An Environmental Study Report dated November 2002 concluded that the existing roadway capacity is inadequate and unable to accommodate new residential and commercial development in the Stittsville area and adjacent Kanata West lands.

“I thank all three levels of government for recognizing the importance this project holds for the immediate and surrounding community. Together we are building a stronger community,” Qadri added.
